FROM THE GIFTS DISCERNMENT TEAM:

Persons to fill the following positions are to be called with their service to begin on January 1, 2020. Please prayerfully consider who you would like to serve in these positions over the next several weeks. (Refer to your directory for current positions.) A CBM will be held TODAY for the congregation to submit the names of persons they would like to be called for each position.

Ministry Team – Music & Worship Chairperson (3 year term) - Chair a team that is responsible for assisting and supporting the pastor in all worship services. Also, serves on the Leadership Team.

Leadership Team Member (1 members, 1 year term) - Serves on the Leadership Team to fulfill its duties to plan, coordinate, integrate, and supervise the ongoing program of the congregation. Also is responsible for long-range planning, initiation or discontinuation of programs, and setting goals and objectives.

Pastoral Relations Team Member (1 member, 2 year term) - Be an advisor and supportive to the pastor and serve to maintain good ministerial relations with the congregation.

Gifts Discernment Team Member (1 female member, 3 year term) - Work with team members to oversee calling of persons for special duties in the church. Maintain a personnel file and help members discern their spiritual gifts and find a way to use those gifts for the ministry of the church.

Trustees – (1 member, 6 year term) – Work with the Trustees as the legal representative of the church. Serve as the Cemetery Committee, and are in charge of all church property.

Annual Conference Delegate for 2020 (1 member, 1 year term) - Attend Annual Conference and report back to the congregation. Held in Grand Rapids, Michigan in 2020.

District Conference Delegates for 2020 (2 members, 1 year term) - Attend District Conference and report back to the congregation.

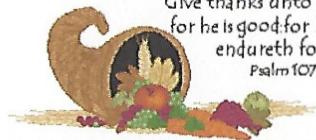
