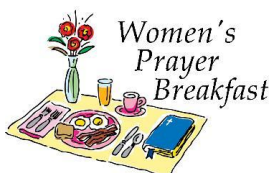

And to become the Lamb of God.**

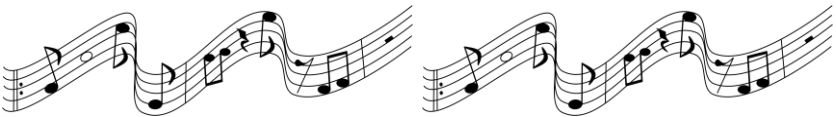

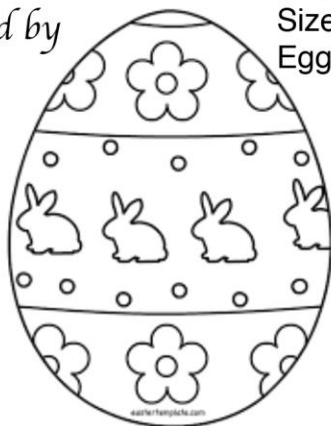
